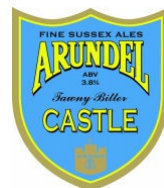

Arundel Castle – AVB 3.8%

A tawny coloured beer with a hoppy aroma. The flavour has a good balance of malt, and hops with a dry hoppy finish.



Ballard's Best Bitter – AVB 4.2%

A copper auburn coloured beer with malty, fruity hoppy aromas. Full bodied, with soft fruit flavours and a dry finish.



Ballard's original brew, and still a best seller, Best Bitter won Gold at the S.E. SIBA Brewing Competition 2008.

WJ King's Horsham Best – AVB 3.8%

This mid-brown coloured session bitter has a wonderful aroma of caramel, roasted malt with a hint of smokiness and dried fruit. This beer has a smooth and full mouth feel whilst the initial taste is of intense nutty malt sweetness which then gives way to a distinct smokiness imparted by the crystal and dark malts. This is followed by and balanced with a long lingering spicy and pine hinted aftertaste chockfull of English hops.



Guest Ale

Langham's Hip Hop – AVB 4.0%

Exactly what it says on the clip. Following in the modern tradition of blonde strongly hopped beers. A classic blonde beer — clean and crisp. The nose is loaded with floral hop aroma while the pale malt flavour is overtaken by a pleasing dry and bitter finish. Silver Medal, SIBA S.E.
