All our Real Ales are from local breweries in Sussex or Hampshire, including Ballard's Best, Arundel Castle Bitter and King's Horsham Best. Guest ales are available and our dedication to good beer has been recognised with our entry in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide.

Arundel Castle - AVB 3.8%

A tawny coloured beer with a hoppy aroma. The flavour has a good balance of malt, and hops with a dry hoppy finish.

Ballard's Best Bitter - AVB 4.2%

A copper auburn coloured beer with malty, fruity hoppy aromas. Full bodied, with soft fruit flavours and a dry finish.

Ballard's original brew, and still a best seller, Best Bitter won Gold at the S.E. SIBA Brewing Competition 2008.

Langham's Hip Hop - AVB 4.0%

Exactly what it says on the clip. Following in the modern tradition of blonde strongly hopped beers. A classic blonde beer — clean and crisp. The nose is loaded with floral hop aroma while the pale malt flavour is overtaken by a pleasing dry and bitter finish. Silver Medal, SIBA S.E.
